



English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) Nurse Aide Training Program

This in-person program combines nurse aide training and English language instruction, and prepares students to succeed as a direct care worker. Students who successfully pass this course will be eligible to take the MA state nurse aide competency exams and earn nurse aide certification. Job readiness training, CPR and first aid certifications are all included in this program.

Program Dates and Location: Class meets **in-person, daily, Monday-Friday** at Greenfield Community College (Greenfield, MA).
