Certification: Automotive Service Excellence ASE (Formerly NATEF); OSHA-10, Hotworks, Basic SP2, option to acquire entry-level Subaru Certifications.

Eligibility: Unemployed or Underemployed; H.S. Diploma or GED/HiSET; 18 years old or older; CORI/SORI approved; Resident of Franklin or Hampshire County
